It's a framework of driving that brings much rigour to the task of driving and demands a higher level of commitment from drivers.

Information is gathered from all around to inform every move, potentially at pace. That information is then used to make clear decisions about speed, the position of the car on the road, appropriate use of brakes, accelerator and gears, and consideration for how other motorists will interpret your actions.

Overall the goal is to achieve 'flow': smooth progress, no drama and taking advantage of the opportunities to 'make progress' where circumstances allow.
